- 1) Lodging.
- 2) Food Service including; A) Three nutritious meals per day and snacks, and; B) Special diets if prescribed by a doctor.
- 3) Laundry facilities.
- 4) Comfortable bed and linens.
- 5) Plan, arrange and/or provide transportation to medical and dental appointments.
- 6) Notify family and other appropriate person(s)/agency(s) of the client's needs.
- 7) 24-hour observation, care and supervision as required.
- 8) Assistance in meeting necessary medical and dental needs, including taking prescribed medications.
- 9) Maintenance or supervision of client cash resources or property.
- 10) Psychological treatment.

The monthly rate for basic services is \$4799.00 per month, payable by the fifth of the month after the services are rendered. Sweeney Youth Homes accepts no liability for a resident after being cancelled from the program.
