

REMOVAL AND DISCHARGE POLICY

Residents of Sweeney Youth Homes will not be discharged without written authorization from a resident's designated representative(s). Discharge may be appropriate if a resident has reached 18 years of age, or has met the needs and services (treatment) plan goals, or if it is determined by Sweeney Youth Home staff that a resident's needs cannot be met within guidelines, objectives and offerings of our program.

Residents may be removed from Sweeney Youth Home for medical reasons, illegal activity, disruption, violence, chronic disregard for published rules, disregard for the safety of self or others, destruction of property, or other behavior determined to be detrimental to other residents.

If a resident is absent without permission and is cancelled by the authorized representative Sweeney Youth Homes is no longer liable for anything involving the resident after leaving the premises.

Whenever possible, residents, their authorized representative(s) and Sweeney Youth Home staff will plan departures so that the transition will be as non-disruptive as possible.
